



## **Peter Zöllner**

### **Member of the Governing Board of the Oesterreichische Nationalbank**

Peter Zöllner has been a Member of the Governing Board of the Oesterreichische Nationalbank (OeNB) and Executive Director of the OeNB's Investment Policy, Internal Services and Statistics Department since 1998. In his capacity as Executive Director, Mr. Zöllner is responsible for the Sections Treasury, Organization and Internal Services, and Statistics as well as for the Equity Interest Management Division. He fulfills supervisory board functions in several OeNB subsidiaries and is affiliated, inter alia, with IMADEC University and the Schumpeter Gesellschaft. Mr. Zöllner holds a doctoral degree in international economics from the Vienna University of Economics and Business Administration.

Mr. Zöllner joined the OeNB in 1980, initially working in the Banking Department. From 1985 to 1987, Mr. Zöllner also held lectures on monetary theory at his alma mater. From 1987 to 1991, he served as the OeNB's Representative in New York and as Consul for Financial Affairs of the Republic of Austria at the General Consulate Office in New York. From 1991 to 1996, Mr. Zöllner served as economic policy advisor to the Austrian Federal Chancellor Franz Vranitzky and rejoined the OeNB as Director of the Treasury Department in 1996.
