Roger Yates has 28 years' experience in the fund management industry as an investment professional and business manager.

After graduating as Bachelor in Arts with Honours in Modern History at Worcester College, Oxford and performing post graduate studies in modern history at the University of Reading, in 1981 he joined GT Management where he remained until 1988 managing UK and international investments, being based also in Hong Kong and San Francisco.

From 1988 to 1994 he worked as Chief Investment Officer at Morgan Grenfell Investment Management. From 1994 to 1999 he worked at LGT / Invesco Global as Chief Investment Officer, with ca. £50 billion of assets under management.

In 1999 he joined as Chief Executive Officer Henderson Global Investors, a UK-based investment firm at that time owned by the Australian investment group AMP. As CEO of Henderson, in 2003 he led the demerger of Henderson from AMP and its simultaneous listing on the London and Australian stock exchanges. At Henderson he created a series of high margin business lines, including Mutual Funds, Private Equity and Property. Under his guidance, the Henderson Group PLC operating margins more than doubled between 2003 and 2008, reaching almost 40%.

After resigning from Henderson in August 2008, he held non-executive directorships at IG Group PLC, JP Morgan Elect Investment Trust PLC, India Investment Partners and F&C Asset Management PLC.

He joined Pioneer Global Asset Management S.p.A. as Chief Executive Officer in January 2010.
